

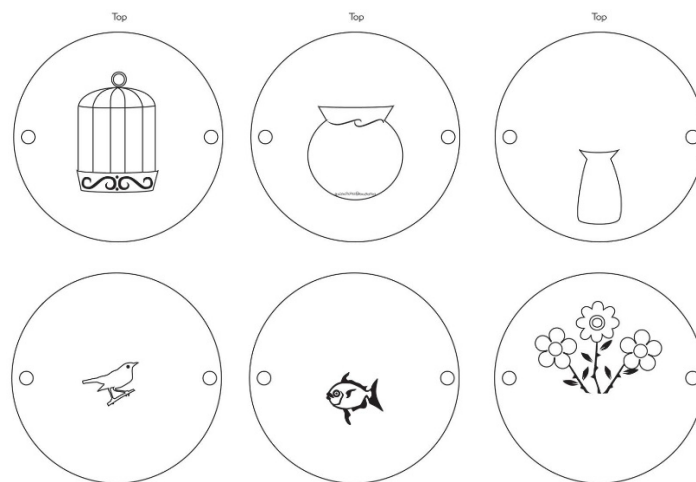
Make a Thaumatrope

You'll need:

- Some cardboard (either an A4 sheet or you can use some from a cereal box or other boxes)
- A compass or small circular object to trace around
- A Pencil and Pen
- Scissors
- Stick/Straw
- Cellotape/Double sided tape or Glue

1. On your cardboard, trace and cut out two identical circles.

2. On each circle, draw an image so that you have two pictures that “go together.” Like below – a bird and cage, a fish and bowl or some flowers and a vase. If you're stuck for an idea, search online and see what others have made.



TIP: try and draw near the middle in order for the two images to line up. You will want to go over your pictures with a pen when you're done, so they show up better.

3. Place a piece of double-sided tape on the straw and apply the first paper circle. Flip over and apply second piece of tape. Carefully align the images back to back and press to secure.

4. Hold the straw between two palms and spin!!! Watch ours in action!
